Introduction

Because of the numerous activities involved in warehouse operations, staff in warehouse settings may be at greater risk for accidents than people who work in areas with more limited activities. Therefore, businesses prioritize warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse dangers is important to preventing accidents. Always be alert to potential hazards and ways to reduce risks. Do whatever is necessary to avoid accidents.

General Hazards

The most common workplace dangers consist of trips, falls and slips. Accidents like these happen as a result of the worker losing their balance and stumbling over an item which has not been correctly put away. Placing or removing items from storage could result in a fumble or slip, potentially resulting in both item and employee to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when employees are moving supplies on various kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. One more common hazard is getting hit by falling things. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of incorrect lifting techniques are one more common danger.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace machinery. Accidents could often be caused from the incorrect use of conveyors, hand trucks and forklift trucks. Warehouse tools, such as pallets, skids, strapping and cutting tools, need to be used cautiously during unpacking, packing and loading.

Hazardous substances, flammable or combustible materials could pose hazards while being stored in a warehouse. Staff must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards while working around hazardous materials.
